

**AICC Secretary booked for remark against Kerala CM**

**KANNUR (KERALA):** AICC Secretary Viswanathan Perumal has been booked for an alleged objectionable remark against Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, police said on Thursday. While speaking during a recent protest march to the Police Commissioner's Office here organised by the opposition Congress party, the leader allegedly made an objectionable remark linking the gold smuggling case prime accused Swapna Suresh with Vijayan.

**Cam in washroom: Principal assaulted**  
**PUNE:** The principal of a private school in Maharashtra's Pune district was assaulted allegedly by members of a right-wing outfit after parents of some students complained that a CCTV was installed in the washroom of girl students, police said on Thursday. A video of the incident, which took place on Tuesday afternoon, went viral on social media platforms. The clip showed the principal, whose clothes were torn, being chased by a mob in the school premises in Talegaon Dabhade area.

**FIR against 7 over conversion**

**NEW DELHI:** The CBI under the directions of the Calcutta High Court has registered an FIR against seven people accused of forced religious conversion in West Bengal's Malda district, officials said on Thursday. The high court ordered the investigation following a writ petition by two sisters, who claimed their husbands Buddh Mandal and Gauranga Mandal were forcibly converted from Hinduism to Islam as punishment for working for a political party which lost the last assembly elections.

**3 dead, 8 injured in Delhi accident**

**NEW DELHI:** Three people died and eight others were injured after a van collided with a DTC bus on the flyover near Loni Gol Chakkar in northeast Delhi's Jyoti Nagar on Thursday, police said. Impact of the accident was such that both the vehicles were mangled and damaged, they said. One of the deceased was identified as Savita (55) while two others -- both male -- are yet to be identified, they said.

**Oppn meet: Lulu will go to B'loru**

**PATNA:** RJD chief Lulu Prasad on Thursday said he will travel to Bengaluru for the meeting of the opposition parties on July 17-18. Speaking to reporters at the Patna airport before leaving for Delhi, he said he will go to Bengaluru for preparing the ground for ousting the Narendra Modi government from the Centre in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. The second meeting of the 'like-minded' opposition parties will be held in Bengaluru on July 17-18. The first meeting was held in Patna on June 23.

**National Anthem disrespect: 14 held**

**SRINAGAR:** More than a dozen people have been arrested for not standing up when the national anthem was played during a function held here in Srinagar in the month of June with Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha in attendance, officials said on Thursday. The administration has also suspended a few police personnel for failing to ensure that everyone stood up while the anthem was played, they said. According to them, some people chose to not stand up during the closing ceremony of the 'Pedal for Peace' cycling event, organised by Jammu and Kashmir Police, on June 25.

**Woman held with heroin worth lakhs**

**MAHARAJGANJ (UP):** A 31-year-old woman was arrested on Thursday from the Indo-Nepal border in Sonauli here with heroin worth around Rs 82 lakh, officials said. In the joint operation by Sashstra Seema Bal (SSB) and local police, Shanti Devi was nabbed during a routine check in the morning when she was on her way to Nepal, Sonauli police station in-charge Abhishek Singh said. A total of 82 grams of heroin worth around Rs 82 lakh in the international market was seized from her, Singh said.

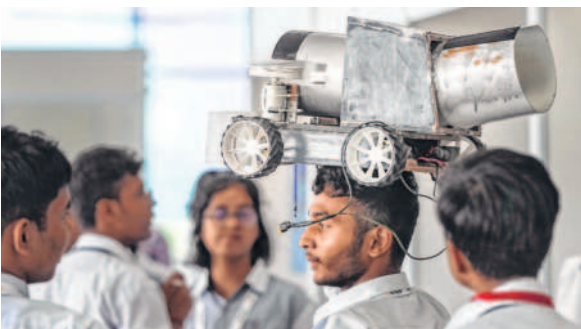
**Cong holds poll preparedness meet with Rajasthan leaders**

Top leaders of the Congress on Thursday held crucial deliberations with the party's leaders in Rajasthan on the poll strategy and preparedness, while also seeking to resolve the tussle between Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and his bete noire Sachin Pilot. Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge, former party chief Rahul Gandhi, AICC general secretary organisation K C Venugopal, AICC in-charge of state Sukhjinder Randhawa, state unit chief Govind Singh Dotasra, Pilot and other senior leaders from Rajasthan met at the party headquarters here at 11 am. Chief Minister Gehlot, who is recovering from fractures in both his toes, is attending the meeting via video conferencing, sources said.

**Delhi court summons CM Gehlot**

A Delhi court on Thursday summoned Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot in a criminal complaint filed by Union Minister Gajendra Singh Sekhawat seeking his prosecution for alleged defamation, saying the Congress leader made imputations "knowing and intending" to harm his reputation. The metropolitan magistrate directed Gehlot to appear before the court on August 7 for allegedly defaming Sekhawat with his remarks on the alleged Sanjivani scam. The case is related to thousands of investors allegedly getting duped of about Rs 900 crore by the Sanjivani Credit Cooperative Society. Sekhawat, the Union Jal Shakti Minister and MP from Jodhpur, has alleged in his complaint that Gehlot has been making defamatory remarks against him over the alleged scam and trying to tarnish his image and affect his political career.

**Kejri lauds tech world Says teaching high school students to solve daily problems using technology is a 'good thing'**

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Thursday said Class 10 and Class 11 students being taught to use technology to solve day-to-day problems now is a "good thing" and added that it is something that did not happen earlier. He was speaking after inaugurating the Delhi Robotics League and HE21 Exhibition at the Thyagaraj Stadium here. "A high-end competition like this has not been held anywhere in India before. Today, there are government as well as private schools that are participating in this competition. But the maximum number of students participating in it are from the School of Specialised Excellence. We can say that the level of education in the government schools of Delhi is much above that in other states," he said. Praising the students for their innovations, he said they have tried to find solutions to real-world problems and called it the best aspect of such an initiative.

**In WB, war within one family & 3 parties**

**Meet the Chanoks -- 'battling' each other as TMC, BJP and Left candidates**

**ARAMBAGH (WB):** The Chanok family of a non-descript village near Aarambagh in West Bengal is witnessing a "war" of sorts with three of its members up against each other as TMC, BJP and Left candidates in the panchayat elections. Sufal Chanok, 78, is the TMC candidate from the Salehpur village, his brother 67-year-old Sukumar Chanak is the CPI candidate while his son Prafulla is the BJP nominee from the seat. "We are fiercely combative on the field as we are miles apart ideologically. But, I have told 'dada' (elder brother) that he has to treat us to mutton curry if he wins, and if I win I will buy a drum of rasogolla and distribute it among our family members, including my 'dada' and 'bhaiya' (nephew)," Sukumar told PTI. A visit to their thatched-roof house, less than a kilometre from the nearest highway, revealed the family's struggle to make ends meet. They do not share a kitchen, but take care of each other, notwithstanding the animosity in the electoral arena.

**'Voting for Congress is voting for BRS'**

**HYDERABAD:** Voting for Congress is the same as voting for the ruling BRS and vice versa, Union Minister and newly-appointed president of the Telangana BJP G Kishan Reddy said on Thursday. Addressing a press conference here jointly with Bandi Sanjay Kumar whom he replaced as state BJP president two days ago, Kishan Reddy said a false campaign is being conducted against the BJP on social media. The BJP would like to come to power in the Assembly elections scheduled to be held later this year by defeating the ruling BRS, he said.

**NOBODY UNHAPPY OVER AJIT JOINING GOVT, SAYS EKNATH**

Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on Thursday said nobody in Shiv Sena is unhappy over NCP leader Ajit Pawar's inclusion in the state ministry. Shinde described as "rumours spread by opposition" reports that his chief ministerial chair may be in jeopardy after Ajit Pawar and eight other NCP MLAs joined his year-old state ministry. Some Shiv Sena legislators had apparently raised concerns after the NCP faction led by Ajit Pawar joining the state government. Shinde presided over a meeting of Shiv Sena MLAs, MLCs and MPs on Wednesday. Ajit Pawar's remark that

he wants to be the CM has created a flutter in political circles. The remark has made the Shinde camp, which is awaiting the Assembly Speaker's ruling on disqualification complaint against its MLAs, nervous. Maharashtra minister Uday Samant, who belongs to the Shinde-led group, said reports about Shinde's resignation were false. Meanwhile, Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Vinayak Raut on Thursday claimed MLAs from the Shiv Sena-led by

**NEW DELHI:** Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Thursday held a meeting with Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) president Sharad Pawar at the latter's residence in Delhi and extended his full support to NCP amid a split in the party. NCP working president and MP Supriya Sule, Maharashtra LoP Jitendra Awhad and other NCP leaders were also present. Talking to the media, NCP leader Sonia Duhan said that Rahul Gandhi has extended his full support to NCP and the opposition parties are also standing with them. "Rahul Gandhi in his meeting with Sharad Pawar said that his full support is with NCP. He also said that Congress is 100 per cent with us and the opposition parties are also standing with NCP", Sonia Duhan said. Notably, NCP supremo Sharad Pawar is in Delhi for a national executive meeting.

**Masked man with bomb enters bank**

**LOOTS RS 24 LAKH**

**SIKAR:** A masked man carrying a bomb barged into a private bank here and looted Rs 24 lakh cash after threatening its staff, police said on Thursday. The incident took place in Yes Bank located in Har-sawa village of this Rajasthan district. The man had threatened to detonate the bomb if the staff failed to give him money, they said. According to police, one of the employees gave him Rs 1.25 lakh, but the miscreant demanded more money following which he entered the cashier room and stashed his bag with cash. "There were no customers inside the bank at the time of the incident. The miscreant had threatened the employees to detonate the bomb that he was carrying. He fled away with Rs 24 lakh cash. The matter is being investigated," Fatehpur SHO Krishna Kant said.

**DELHI'S AURANGZEB LANE IS NOW APJ ABDUL KALAM LANE**

**NEW DELHI:** The Aurangzeb Lane in the Lutyens' Delhi has been renamed as Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Lane. The rechristened lane connects the Abdul Kalam Road with Prithvi Raj Road in central Delhi. The New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) workers unveiled a signboard bearing the name of India's 11th president here on Thursday. According to an official, the NDMC approved the renaming of the lane in a meeting of its members on June 28. The council changed the erstwhile Aurangzeb Road named after the 17th-century Mughal ruler to Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Road in August 2015. NDMC vice chairman Satish Upadhyay last week announced that the council approved the renaming of 'Aurangzeb Lane' under the NDMC area as 'Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Lane'. "To respect the sentiments of people, the need to recognise and honour great men and women of our times, roads/ streets/ institutions have been re-named in the past," it read.
