Modi tweeted, "On his death anniversary, paying tributes to our former Prime Minister Shri Rajiv Gandhi."

3 children among 7 killed in car crash in Karnataka

DHARWAD: Seven people, including three children were killed and 13 others were injured when the cab in which they were travelling crashed into a tree at the Baad Cross, around 12 km from here, in the small hours of Saturday, police said. The injured have been admitted to the Karnataka Institute of Medical Sciences, where their condition is said to be serious. While four people died on the spot, others succumbed to their injuries in the hospital.

K'taka CM to hold talks with 18 tycoons during WEF meet in Davos

BENGALURU: Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai on Saturday said he would interact with at least 18 global business leaders during his Davos tour to participate in the World Economic Forum (WEF) annual meeting on May 23 and 24. Bommai also said the eight ministers for administering eight different Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike zones will be finalised tonight.

Bommai holds talks with BJP leadership on RS, Council polls

NEW DELHI/BENGALURU: Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai, who paid a sudden visit to Delhi sparking off speculation in political circles, on Saturday said there was no discussion with the BJP's central leadership on Cabinet reorg or expansion. The consultations during his visit revolved around the upcoming polls for Rajya Sabha and Legislative Council. Elections to seven Council seats will be held on June 3, and the biennial elections to four seats of the Rajya Sabha from Karnataka on June 10.

Kerala to recruit 100 tribal youth as excise civil officers

THRISSUR: The Kerala govt will recruit 100 youth, including women, from various tribal hamlets across the state as excise civil officers, Excise and Local Self Government Minister M V Govindan said here on Saturday. In view of reported inflow of banned contrabands in the hamlets, local tribal youth from there would be appointed to the posts through special recruitment to tackle this issue, he said. The flow of illicit drugs into the southern state seems to be on the rise nowadays and it has become a menace mainly affecting youth, the minister said.

Kerala CM pays rich tribute to Nipah warrior nurse

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Saturday paid homage to Lini Puthusseri, a nurse who lost her life by contracting the disease while attending to affected persons, on her fourth death anniversary, and said her memories would serve as inspiration to the state's fight against the pandemic. The anniversary of Lini's demise was also a renewal of the memories of the struggle waged by the people of Kerala against the deadly disease, he said in a Facebook post.

Delhi court convicts former Haryana CM Chautala in DA case



NEW DELHI: The Rouse avenue court of Delhi on Saturday convicted Ex-Haryana chief minister Om Prakash Chautala in a disproportionate assets (DA) case filed by the CBI. Special Judge (PC Act) Vikas Dhull, on Saturday, while ordering the conviction of Chautala, said he will hear the arguments on the quantum of punishment on May 26, 2022. In the case, the CBI had filed a charge sheet against Chautala on March 26, 2010, and held him responsible for allegedly amassing assets worth Rs 6.09 crore, much disproportionate to his legitimate income, between 1993 and 2006. The case was filed on a complaint by Haryana Congress leader Shamsher Singh Surjewala. OP Chautala is a former CM of Haryana from Indian National Lok Dal and son of 6th Dy PM Chaudhary Devi Lal. Chautala was recently released from the Tihar Jail on 2 July 2021.

Quad working to implement positive agenda, says India

NEW DELHI

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, US President Joe Biden and other Quad leaders are expected to deliberate on the challenges and opportunities in the Indo-Pacific as well as pressing global issues at their summit talks on May 24 in Tokyo.

Modi is visiting Japan on May 23 and 24 to attend the summit.

Foreign Secretary Vinay Mohan Kwatra said on Saturday that the upcoming summit would provide the leaders with an opportunity to take stock of the progress made so far under the Quad framework and give guidance for the future.

Apart from participating in the Quad summit, Modi would also hold bilateral meetings with Biden, Japanese Prime Minister Fumio Kishida and his Australian counterpart.

Modi will also engage with the Japanese business community and the Indian diaspora.

Modi has 23 engagements in 40 hours of stay in Japan for Quad summit

NEW DELHI: Prime Minister Narendra Modi will have 23 engagements, including meetings with three world leaders, in around 40 hours of stay in Japan where he will join US President Joe Biden and prime ministers of Australia and Japan at the Quad summit in Tokyo on May 24, official sources said. They said Modi during his visit will have business, diplomatic and community interactions. He will interact with over 30 Japanese CEOs and also with hundreds of Indian diaspora members.

"Quad cooperation is anchored in the shared values and commitment to the principles of democracy, international law, rules-based international order as also the vision of a free, open and inclusive Indo-Pacific," Kwatra said at a media briefing.

"Since its first summit, Quad has been working to implement a positive and constructive agenda with a strong focus on enabling peace, prosperity and stability in the Indo-Pacific region," he said.

Asked whether China's aggressive behaviour in the region including along its border with India would figure in the Quad summit, Kwatra said the leaders are expected to deliberate on "challenges and opportunities" in the Indo-Pacific region in accordance with the agenda of the deliberations. To a question on India's stand on the Ukraine conflict, he said it is "amply clear" and that it has been reiterated many times.

Kwatra said right from the time when hostilities began, India called for an immediate cessation of hostilities and has been maintaining that dialogue remained the best policy to resolve it.

Bodies of all 10 trapped workers recovered from collapsed tunnel

JAMMU: Bodies of all the 10 trapped workers were recovered from the debris of an under construction tunnel that collapsed near Khoooni Nallah area of Jammu and Kashmir's Ramban district on Thursday, the police said on Saturday.

"A case of negligence has been registered following the collapse of an under construction tunnel in Jammu and Kashmir's Ramban on May 19," a police officer said.

The deceased have been identified as Jadav Roy, Gautam Roy, Sudhir Roy, Dipak Roy and Parimal Roy all from West Bengal, and Shiva Chouhan from Assam, Nepalese national Navaraj Chaudhary and Kushi Ram Chaudhary, and Mohammad Muzaffar and Mohammad Ishirat, both residents of Marog, district Ramban.

KCR, Kejri teaming up for anti-Cong Oppn front

NEW DELHI: Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal are teaming up to make an opposition front against the BJP minus the Congress.

K. Chandrashekar Rao, on his visit to Delhi on Saturday, will be visiting Mohalla clinics along with Kejriwal. He is also likely to issue a statement later in the day. Earlier, Tamil Nadu CM Stalin had also visited Delhi. Both Arvind Kejriwal and KCR share good personal relationship and have a understanding with Trinamool Congress chief Mamata Banerjee. The Telangana CM will be meeting other leaders also and this is his second leg of meeting with like-minded

IMD: Wet spell in N-W to peak on May 23

NEW DELHI: Amid the scorching heat throughout the country, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) on Friday informed that the wet spell over Northwest and east India from May 21 to May 24 will reach peak intensity on May 23.

IMD also mentioned dust-storm activity at isolated places, very likely over west Rajasthan between May 22 and 24. The department also predicted strong surface winds with wind speed reaching 30 to 40 kilometres per hour (Kmph) over Rajasthan on Saturday. During the next 5 days, scattered to fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds are likely over Bihar, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha.

Areas, including J&K, Himachal and Uttarakhand, may have fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds, informed the IMD.

'Assam-Arunachal border dispute likely to be resolved before 2023'

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Saturday said that the inter-state boundary dispute between Arunachal Pradesh and Assam is likely to be resolved before 2023.

Asserting that efforts are underway to make Northeast insurgency-free, he claimed 9,000 militants from the region have surrendered during the last eight years of the Narendra Modi government at the Centre.

Addressing the golden jubilee celebrations of Ramakrishna Mission School at Narottam Nagar in Tirap district of Arunachal Pradesh, Shah said, "Almost 60 per cent of the inter-state boundary dispute between Assam and Meghalaya has been resolved amicably. I am confident that the dispute between Arunachal and Assam will be settled before 2023," he said. He said that the Centre is committed to

bringing peace and development to the region.

"Youths of Northeast no longer carry guns and petrol bombs. They are now carrying laptops and are launching startups. This is the path of development that the Centre has envisaged for the region," he said. "Manipur, which was earlier known for bandhs and blockades for 200 days a year, is now witnessing a sea of change without any bandh during the last five years of BJP rule in the state," he said.

Shivling found in Gyanvapi is one of 12 Jyotirlingas: VHP

NEW DELHI: VHP chief Alok Kumar on Friday agreed with the Supreme Court's order in the Gyanvapi mosque case and claimed that the Hindu side will be able to prove that the Shivling found is one of the 12 Jyotirlingas.

"We agree with the SC that this matter is complicated and this requires a serious and experienced judge. SC has said the district court will look into it. We agree with the SC," he said. He said that they will be able to prove that 'Shivling' found inside the Gyanvapi is a Jyotirlinga. "We believe that it is Shivling because Nandi is looking at it and the location suggests that it is one of the original Jyotirling, out of 12 Jyotirlingas and vaju khana of the complex has been built over the ruins of the desecrated old temple invaded by the Mughals. We will be able to prove it to the court and the SC will decide this case. The judge has been authorized to take the local commissioner's report and we will prove it is the original Jyotirlinga," he said. He further claimed that the 1991 Act will not be applicable to Gyanvapi case. On the Places of Worship Act 1991, he said, "I do not believe that 1991 Act will be applicable on this. Because the act said that if the religious place works on another act that this act is not effective. There is already a separate law for Kashi temple and today the SC has also indicated that Act does not prevent the trial of this matter."

BIHAR STORM: 33 killed; CM announces ex-gratia

As many as 33 people in the 16 districts of Bihar died on Friday due to the storm and lightning.

Chief Minister Nitish Kumar has announced a financial aid of Rs 4 lakh to kin of people who lost their lives in the incidents. The chief minister's office said that after assessing the crop and house damage, instructions will be given to provide assistance to the affected families. The storm that occurred in the city on Thursday evening, has destroyed several houses and caused immense damage to the state. The locals in Katihar were affected by the destruction due to the natural calamity. The intensity of

the storm was such that even the roofs of several houses were blown away, while some electric poles fell off and trees were uprooted.

Expressing grief over the loss of lives due to storms, Kumar said "the government will grant ex-gratia of Rs 4 lakh each to the kin of those who died due to the storm and lightning." (He tweeted in Hindi) Modi tweeted in Hindi, "Deeply saddened to know about the number of deaths due to thunderstorm and lightning in several districts of Bihar. May God give strength to the bereaved families to bear this immense loss. The local administration under the supervision of the state government is actively engaged in the relief and rescue work of the victims."

Norwester lashes West Bengal, 4 killed

A nor wester on Saturday in South Bengal, Kolkata and adjoining areas may have brought some relief but also left behind a tragic trail. Five students who went for rowing at Rabindra Sarovar as part of their school competition, drowned due to the sudden storm and heavy downpour. Pushan Sadhu Khan and Sourdeep Chatterjee students of South Point School, who were untraceable after their rowing boat turned turtle were later rushed to the hospital where they were declared brought dead.
