Former chief ministers Kamal Nath will conduct 70 rallies and Digvijay Singh will conduct 60 rallies. AICC general secretary and state in-charge Randeep Singh Surjewala will conduct 30 rallies in the state.

He will reach Satna on November 10.

## Illicit liquor worth Rs 7.2L seized

Bhopal: Excise department of the city seized illicit liquor worth Rs 7.20 lakh during raids at several localities on Thursday. Excise controller Rajendra Jain told Free press the team raided areas such as Mugaliya Kot, Sukhi Sewaniya, Balampur valley, Prempura and Bhabhadra. In some of these areas, the illicit liquor was concealed in drainages, while in other areas, the packets were hanging to the branches of the trees. Officials seized a total of 634 litres of country-made liquor, and 6055 kilograms of Mahua lahaan.

## Two jail guards under scanner after Rs 31K confiscated from 4 prisoners

Two guards have been issued show cause notices for dereliction of duty after Rs 31,000 found in clothes of four prisoners at Central Jail Bhairavgarh. Mukesh, Narendra, Kuldeep and Sanju, short-term prisoners lodged in the jail, were assigned of office, garden and other

works. For this, prisoners were made to work in the jail premises. Their clothes were kept in the office outside the jail. When their clothes were checked four days ago, a total of Rs 31,000 was found. Jail superintendent Manoj Sahu said that notice has been issued to jail guards Sanjay Vyasa and Premnarayan Khatri. Both have been asked to

reply within three days. Apart from this, strict action has been taken against the prisoners. The parole of all four has been stopped for one year and the week's earned remission has been cancelled. A letter has been written to the jail headquarters to shift all four to other jails. Soon, the four prisoners will be sent to other jails, he said.

## Congress sowing seeds of hatred against Hindus: Rameshwar Sharma

## Stones hurled at Cong candidates' convoy in Satna One person arrested in connection with incident

The convoy of Congress MLA Nilanshu Chaturvedi, who is contesting the assembly elections from his current seat Chitrakot, was attacked with stones in the intervening night of Wednesday and Thursday in Satna district, the police said. No one was injured in the incident. The police have arrested one person in connection with the incident. The accused is a truck driver from Raisen, who was in an inebriated state at that time. The incident occurred under the Majhgawan police station limits when the legislator was returning after election campaigning.

Though the MLA's car was not hit, the vehicles following him came under the attack. Majhgawan police station Inspector Aditya Narayan Dhurve of said, the complaint lodged by the supporters of Chaturvedi stated that somebody hurled stones at the MLA's con-

voys at Michkurin village between 12 am and 12.30 am, in which the window panes of some vehicles were broken. The car in which Chaturvedi was travelling did not come under attack, however, some other vehicles in the convoy were hit by stones.

"The Congress candidate was returning after campaigning when his cavalcade was attacked. No one was injured in the incident," he said. The police have registered a case under section 336 (rash or negligent act to endanger human life) and 427 (mischievous causing loss or damage) of Indian Penal Code (IPC) against the accused.

## College girl raped by married youth

A sensational case of rape of a college student living in Nagjhiri area has come to light. In this, a Muslim youth seduced a Hindu girl and took her with him to Ajmer. After raping her there, he took her to his in-laws' house in Rajgarh Bhaora. Here the girl called her mother and narrated her whole situation following which the police arrested the accused. A college student living in the Nagjhiri area told

the police that she knew Farzan Khan, who lives in the area, for the last four years. "A few days ago, accused Farzan said that he loves me and wants to marry me, on which I told him that I cannot marry you as you belong to Muslim community. So he pressured me to convert. After getting seduced by him, he called me near Indore Aurbindo Hospital at 9 am on October 27, here we kept roaming in Rajwada. Farzan took me to Ajmer that very night. Here in a hotel near Delhi Gate, he

tried to rape me, and when I refused he threatened to kill my family members. After which I had to agree with him." The victim said that after Ajmer, the accused took her to Bhaora Rajgarh. Here his wife and father-in-law came to take them and it was here that she came to know that he was already married. On this, the girl called her mother and told her the whole incident. After this, the police arrested the accused Farzan and handed over the student to her family.
