Internal bickerings among state leaders anger BJP central think-tank

SHAH WILL GIVE TRUMPET CALL NEXT MONTH

The central leadership is angry with the international squabbling in the state Bharatiya Janata Party. The central leadership may soon hold a meeting with the senior leaders of the state unit to prevent party men from issuing statements against each other. The information about wrangling among the ministers from Sagar, issuing of statement against Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia and factionalism in the party reached the central leadership. According to sources, the

national organisational general secretary BL Santosh sought feedback on all the issues. Sources further said the central organisation might hold a meeting with the state unit of the party over the ensuing election in the state.

The core group of the party was set up to maintain a cordial relationship among its leaders, but the infighting in the party before the election has come to light. So, BL Santosh may be present at the next meeting of the core group. Similarly, Union Home Minister Amit Shah will give a trumpet call for the election in the first week of the next month.

The central leadership of the party will plunge into action in the poll-bound states. So, the party leaders may be given election-related responsibilities next month.

NTCA team to review urban tiger management today

Bhopal: The members of National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) will review urban tiger management during their visit to Bhopal on Sunday. The urban tiger management is carried out through satellite-based surveillance system. Forest department said that apart from seeing presentation on urban tiger management, the NTCA team will visit Kaliasot and Kerwa where tigers are often spotted. There, they will interact with forest staff and will inquire about coexistence of tigers and humans. They may visit Van Vihar National Park to inspect facilities. Meanwhile, district forest

officials want to use the opportunity to place demands before NTCA team. For instance, NTCA help might be sought for fencing jungle areas and infrastructure related works. The officials may also demand replacing old, patrol vehicles. "We need three to four new vehicles," a district forest officer said.

Union minister for forest Bhupendra Yadav will attend NTCA meeting to be held at Indian Institute of Forest Management on Monday. At the meeting, discussion about Kuno's cheetah project, which is in the eye of storm due to death of three adult cheetahs and three cubs, is also likely to take place.

NON-RENEWAL OF LEASE Stud farm worth Rs 350 cr freed from Mumbai resident

Teams of Bhopal Municipal Corporation (BMC) and district administration on Saturday freed 20 acres of land worth Rs 350 crore allotted to Mumbai resident Harsh Gokuldas for stud farm at Sewnia God village in vicinity of Sairsapata in Bhabhadra.

Collector had cancelled its lease on June 1, 2020. Divisional commissioner had rejected the appeal of Harsh Gokuldas for lease renewal. Lease was not renewed as Gokuldas was using land for his own purpose instead of stud farm. The land was leased out in 1963 for 30 years. After every 30 years, lease was to be renewed. However, this time, lease was not renewed. In joint operation of district admin-

istration and BMC administration, construction was demolished and the land was freed. TT Nagar tetsildar Avnish Mishra said, "Gokuldas was allotted 20-acre land in 1963 for horse rearing. But lease was not renewed so district administration demolished all the construction and freed the land."

Gold loan company heist

Mastermind's accomplices held from Rajasthan

The joint team comprising of police and crime branch officials arrested three other accused, in connection with the robbery bid that took place at a gold loan company in Piplani on April 5, official sources said.

The police said that the accused trio was involved with the kingpin in the gold loan company heist case and have been arrested by the team from Rajasthan. As per officials, four masked and armed robbers had tried to rob a gold loan company on April 5. The robbery bid had been foiled due to the agility of the manager, who raised an alarm and the accused fled from the spot instantly.

Earlier, the mastermind of the gang, identified as Prashant alias Raja had been arrested by the Piplani police, while the other three accused were at large. By questioning Raja and amassing all technical evidence, the police learnt that all the remaining accused were in Rajasthan.
