Offered biscuit to dog owner to feed it: Rahul on viral video

GUMLA (JHARKHAND)
Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday said he offered a biscuit to a dog owner to feed the animal after it refused to eat from his hands. His clarification came after a video showing him offering a biscuit rejected by a dog to a person went viral on social media, with BJP leaders alleging this was how he treated workers of his party. "The dog was nervous and shivering... When I gave it a biscuit, the dog got scared. "Then, I gave the biscuit to the owner, saying it will eat from your hand. Then, the owner gave it and the dog ate the biscuit. So, what is the issue?" Gandhi told reporters when queried about it. "I don't understand what is the BJP's obsession with



the dog?" Gandhi added. The video was shot in Jharkhand's Dhanbad district on February 4 during the 'Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra', party spokesperson Rakesh Sinha said. The owner of the dog, expressing happiness, said, "The dog got clicked with Rahul Gandhi, who also offered it biscuits." The incident, however, stirred a controversy, with

BJP HITS OUT

NEW DELHI
Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma has launched a fresh attack on Congress leader Rahul Gandhi over a viral video where the Wayanad MP was seen giving a dog's biscuit to a person after the animal refused to eat it during his 'Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra'. The purported video which went viral on social media, showed Gandhi petting a puppy and then feeding it biscuits. At one point, the puppy refuses to eat and Gandhi then gives the biscuits to a person standing by his side. However, the video shared by the official Bharat Jodo Yatra handle did not include the biscuit clip. The BJP had targeted the Congress leader over the video, alleging that Rahul Gandhi was 'mistreating his supporters'. Once associated with

Congress, Himanta Biswa Sarma who has often recounted an earlier incident where he claimed that during a meeting with Rahul Gandhi, the latter's pet dog, Pidi, was given biscuits from a plate, which were then offered to the Congress leaders present. hit out at the Wayanad MP, saying that he and his family could not make him "eat the biscuit". "I am a proud Assamese and Indian. I refused to eat and resigned from the Congress."

'PM CALLS HIMSELF OBC AND THEN GETS CONFUSED'

Pressing on the importance of the Caste Census, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday said that Prime Minister Modi calls himself OBC, and then gets confused, adding "Caste wise Census is important because if we want to give them participation then it is necessary to count them first." Rahul said that this question is not just of one person but of the people of India. "PM calls himself OBC and then gets confused. Earlier he was saying that there are only two castes in India, the rich and the poor. 50 per cent of the population of India belongs to the OBC category, Dalit is 15 per cent and Adivasi is eight per cent. "We want a caste census. This is important because if we want to give them participation then it is necessary to count them first," he said.

Court allows Sanjay to take oath in RS

NEW DELHI
A Delhi court on Tuesday granted fresh permission to AAP leader Sanjay Singh, arrested in alleged excise scam, to attend Parliament to take oath as a Rajya Sabha MP. Special Judge MK Nagpal allowed Singh to go to Parliament in police custody either on February 8 or 9. The judge passed the order on the application filed by Singh, seeking directions to the jail superintendent concerned for taking him physically to Rajya Sabha to take oath as its member. The judge had earlier on February 3 allowed a similar application filed by Singh. However, the AAP leader could not take oath despite reaching Parliament on Monday. Official sources cited the direction of Rajya Sabha on August 11, 2023 that Singh's suspension for unruly conduct during the monsoon session will remain in force and he cannot attend proceedings till the Privileges Committee submits its report and it is considered by the House. The application sought direction to the authorities concerned to take him again to Rajya Sabha on February 8 or 9, claiming that though Singh was taken to the House on Monday according to the court order, "the oath could not be administered to him due to certain reasons". Enforcement of Directorate (ED), the anti-money laundering agency, had arrested Singh on October 4.

KOLKATA COUPLE HELD FOR MURDERING PUNE BIZMAN IN GUWAHATI

GUWAHATI
In a tragic end to a love triangle, a couple hailing from Kolkata was arrested on the charge of murdering a Pune businessman in a luxury hotel in Guwahati, police said on Tuesday. Addressing a press conference here, Guwahati Police Commissioner Diganta Barah said the incident took place on Monday afternoon at the hotel, where the three persons had stayed. "The victim, identified as 44-year-old Sandeep Suresh Kamble from Pune, came in contact with the woman during one of his business trips to Kolkata in September 2023," he added.

'97% political cases filed by ED are against opposition'

NEW DELHI
Shiv Sena (UBT) Rajya Sabha member Priyanka Chaturvedi on Tuesday said 97 per cent political cases filed by the Enforcement Directorate are against opposition leaders, while the conviction rate is just two-three per cent. Speaking at the Lokmat National Conclave here, Chaturvedi raised concerns about the state of democracy in the country. She alleged that there is a decline in democracy and referred to the suspension of 146 MPs in Parliament during the winter session. "When does democracy come under threat?... If we



Priyanka Chaturvedi claimed that ED investigations have increased four times since the BJP came to power in 2014. She said, "Since 2014, when they (BJP) came to power, ED investigations have seen a four times increase. The increase is on (raids on) opposition... But who is giving a clean chit to those who join the BJP? What did the PM say about Ajit Pawar? In one election rally, he said the NCP is a Naturally Corrupt Party. In 48 hours, he (Pawar) joined BJP and all files closed," she said.

Bill cleared to curb paper leaks, cheating in exams

NEW DELHI
The Lok Sabha has cleared the Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Bill, 2024, which aims to address malpractices and irregularities in government recruitment exams by imposing strict penalties, including a maximum jail term of 10 years and a fine of up to Rs 1 crore. The Lok Sabha passed the Bill after rejecting some amendments proposed by opposition members. The Bill, presented by Union Minister Jitendra Singh, stated that there is no specific substantive law to deal with unfair means

The LS passed the Bill after rejecting some amendments proposed by opposition members adopted or offences committed by various entities involved in the conduct of public examinations. "It is imperative that elements that exploit vulnerabilities of the examination system are identified and effectively dealt with by comprehensive Central legislation," the Bill reads. Under the Bill, "Public Examinations" will include exams conducted by the Union Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission, Railway Recruitment Boards, Insti-

tute of Banking Personnel Selection, Ministries or Departments of the Central Government, National Testing Agency, and such other authorities as may be notified by the Centre. Under this Bill, candidates, as defined, will not be liable for action within the purview of the Bill and will continue to be covered under the extant administrative provisions of the concerned public examination authority. According to the bill, unfair means will be punishable with imprisonment for a term not less than three years but which may extend to five years and with a fine of up to Rs 10 lakh.

SOREN OWNED LAND ILLEGALLY: BJP

RANCHI: The BJP's Jharkhand unit on Tuesday released a video clip claiming that arrested former chief minister Hemant Soren does own a piece of land, which the ED accused him of illegally acquiring. The claim was made a day after Soren challenged the BJP in the Jharkhand assembly to prove corruption charges against him, asserting

that if the accusations were proved, he would quit politics. Soren was arrested by the ED on January 31 after a marathon seven-hour interrogation in connection with a money laundering case linked to an alleged land fraud. The 48-year-old JMM executive president resigned as the chief minister before the arrest. In the 58-second video clip released

by the opposition BJP, a man, identifying himself Santosh Munda, is seen saying that the piece of land at Bargain in Ranchi district belongs to Hemant Soren. Talking to reporters, Jharkhand BJP president Babul Marandi said, "The man is the caretaker of the land. It is known to everyone in the area who its owner is."
