Sidda rules out resignation amid MUDAROW

Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah on Friday emphatically ruled out his resignation, contending he had not made any "mistake" in the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) case.

Responding to a media query on BJP state President B.Y. Vijayendra's demand for his resignation following Governor Thawarchand Gehlot's consent for prosecution against him in the MUDA case, Siddaramaiah retorted: "He (Vijayendra) should resign from the post of state BJP President. Should I submit my resignation just because he asks for it? Do I have to resign because Vijayendra is asking for it? I demand his resignation - will he resign?"

"I have not made any mistake in the MUDA case. Tomorrow (Saturday), the matter will again come up before the court and arguments will take place. Let us wait and see what happens. I have not committed any mistake. Tomorrow, all our MLAs, MPs, and MLCs are meeting the Governor to inquire about the cases against Union Minister H.D. Kumaraswamy, and former BJP ministers Murugesh Nirani, Shashikala Jolle, and Janardhana Reddy. They have been pending for a long time," he told media persons in Hubballi.

Andhra Legislature to go paperless

WASHROOM HORROR: CM Chandrababu Naidu orders probe**Hidden camera scandal in Andhra girls' hostel**

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on Friday ordered an enquiry over allegations of hidden cameras installation in a girl student's washroom of an engineering college here. Hundreds of students have been protesting at S R Gudlavalluru Engineering College in Krishna district since Thursday midnight over the incident.

"Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu ordered an enquiry on girl students protesting over hidden cameras in their hostel at Gudlavalluru Engineering College in Krishna district," said an official release.

**'MGMT HUSHED UP THE ISSUE'**

Female students of an engineering college complained to Mines Minister K Ravindra on Friday that the management attempted to hush up the issue of hidden cameras allegedly found in a women's washroom and also went to the extent of threatening students who lodge a complaint over the matter. The students poured out their woes to Ravindra, who reached the

college with the district collector and superintendent of police, following instructions from Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu. "We (students) don't have faith in the college management as it has been trying to hush up the matter (alleged hidden cameras issue) for the past three days. The college management threatened to act against us if we complain over this issue," said an official statement.

Meanwhile, police registered a case over the alleged incident but noted that there were no such hidden cameras.

"No hidden cameras were found in girls' hostel. No evidence of allegations was found. There's no need for girls to worry over this issue," said an official statement, adding that police checked laptops, mobiles & other electronic gadgets of the suspects in presence of students and college staff.

Man allegedly flashes student inside TN hostel

CHENNAI: A woman student has alleged that she was sexually harassed inside a hostel room at the National Institute of Technology (NIT) in Tamil Nadu's Tiruchirappalli last night. The shocking incident sparked widespread outrage and late-night protests by the NIT students.

An outsourced worker, hired to fix Wi-Fi issues, was arrested on Friday following a complaint by the student.

The accused had allegedly flashed and misbehaved with the student on Thursday night when she was alone in the room, investigators said. The incident triggered protests, with students demanding swift action against the accused.
