CHENNAI: Gold weighing over three kilograms worth Rs 1.38 crore was seized at the international airport here and two passengers were arrested in this connection, the customs department said on Monday. Acting on specific inputs, the department authorities intercepted two passengers who arrived from Kuala Lumpur and Dubai respectively in the last two days and seized the yellow metal which was concealed in their inner garments, a press release said.

Tailor, chemist killings: BJP playing polarisation' game: Cong

AMRAVATI: Maharashtra Congress leader and former state minister Yashomati Thakur on Monday attacked the Bharatiya Janata Party over the recent killings of a tailor in Udaipur in Rajasthan and a chemist here. Tailor Kanhaiya Lal was killed on June 28 in the north-western state, while chemist Umesh Kolhe was murdered a week earlier on June 21. Police probe in the two states has revealed the murders were linked to social media messages of the victims in support of Nupur Sharma, who was suspended from the BIP for objectionable comments against Prophet Mohammad.

Known for hitting the headlines for wrong reasons, ruling BJP legislator Vikram Saini's viral video has stirred controversy again.

In response to the Nupur Sharma controversy and the violence that followed, Saini has made provocative statements while addressing a gathering of traders in Wajidpur Kavalai village of Jansath tehsil of Muzaffarnagar. The traders had organised a function to felicitate Union Minister Sanjeev Baliyan and MLA Vikram Saini.

In the viral video the BJP legislator is seen giving advice to traders of Muzaffarnagar to keep weapons, including pistols in their shops besides two boxes of stones and 4-5 shovel bents.

He asked traders as to how long the police would save them in case of an attack by a particular community. "By the time the police arrived, they would set your shops and houses on fire. So, the traders must prepare themselves to counter goons of a particular community," said Saini in the video. A local person captured the

ZUBAIR MOVES SESSIONS COURT FOR BAIL

NEW DELHI: Alt News co-founder Mohammed Zubair has moved a bail application in sessions court at the Patiala House courts, seeking bail in the case related to an "objectionable tweet" allegedly posted by him against a Hindu deity. The plea will be heard on Tuesday. On July 2, Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Snigdha Sarvaria at the Patiala House Courts rejected the bail plea of Zubair in connection with the case and granted his 14-day custody as sought by the Delhi Police. "Since the matter is at the initial stage of investigation and given the overall facts and circumstances of the case and nature and gravity of the offences alleged against the accused, no ground for grant of bail is made out," Sarvaria said while dismissing Zubair's bail plea.

MOOSEWALA MURDER CASE

SC refuses to entertain plea to transfer case to CBI

NEW DELHI:•The Supreme Court on Monday refused to entertain Punjab BJP leader Jagjit Singh's plea seeking to transfer the investigation in the Sidhu Moose Wala murder case to the CBI.

A bench of justices Ajay Rastogi and Abhay S. Oka also remarked that such matters should not be given any political colour and they don't appreciate such practice. However, the Court also remarked that the court has to work openly for all the people. Meanwhile, the Court adjourned to July 18 hearing on another plea of accused Lawrence Bishnoi's father challenging the transit remand to Punjab police and asked the Punjab state to file a reply on the plea. Advocate Vikram Chaudhri, appeared for the father of gangster Bishnoi while senior advocate AM Singhvi appeared for Punjab. On June 14, the Patiala House Court of Delhi allowed Punjab Police to arrest Gangster Lawrence Bishnoi in connection with Singer Sidhu Moosewala murder case and also allowed Punjab Police transit application. The court also directed Punjab Police to ensure that the medical examination of accused Bishnoi be conducted as per law/rules before leaving Delhi and also before his production before the concerned Court of CJM, Mansa, Punjab.

OPS pulled up for rushing to court EPS is new boss

CHENNAI: In a day of dramatic developments in the AIADMK, Edappadi K Palaniswami (EPS) was elected its interim general secretary and O Panneerselvam (OPS) was expelled from the primary membership. The party office were also "sealed" by the revenue authorities following a clash between their supporters on Monday.

AIADMK facing its biggest challenge in the absence of charismatic leaders at the helm. It is likely to witness further turmoil when OPS, miserably outnumbered in popular support within the party, drags the affairs to the courts and the ECI. The day began with OPS, who is opposed to migrating to unitary leadership, heading to the AIADMK headquarters in Royapettah in

Chennai. His arrival triggered clashes between his supporters and those of former chief minister Palaniswami. He entered the headquarters after his supporters broke open the doors and stayed put. Meanwhile, the Madras HC gave green signal for the party executive and general council meeting, which OPS had challenged, just 15 minutes before the event was scheduled to begin.
