

EVMs don't speak therefore targeted, ex-CEC Rawat

BHOPAL: Former Chief Election Commissioner, OP Rawat has reiterated his stand on EVMs. He said that there is no need to worry as EVMs are completely safe and cannot be manipulated. Rawat said that EVMs cannot speak therefore they are being targeted constantly. Replying to a question on integrity of election commission of India, Rawat said that one should understand the pressure that ECI undergoes. "Its (ECI) condition is like a match referee. It has to sustain pressure from both the sides," said Rawat. It was on demand of the Opposition that VVPAT slips are being counted and matched with the machines therefore one should not doubt integrity of election commission, he added.

Flags Bhopal, Indore, Jabalpur red

Party confident of winning 16 seats, prospects shaky on 13

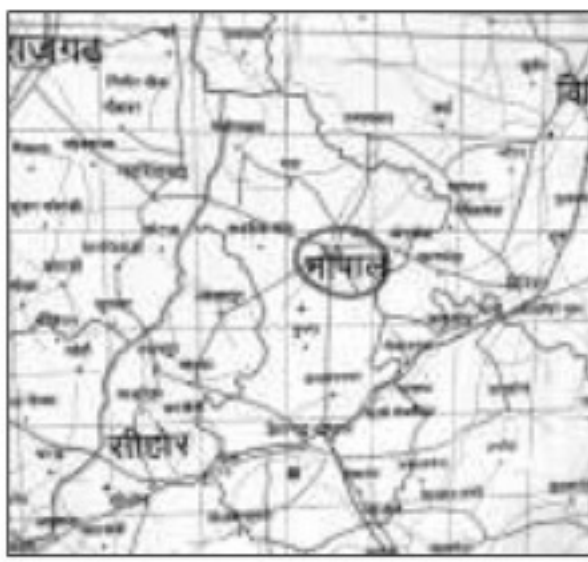
While the Congress leadership in state is quite confident of the poll outcome in Guna and Chhindwara, they are keeping it finger crossed for Bhopal, Indore and Jabalpur.

As the state eagerly waits for the poll outcome, the political leaders are busy making assessments and calculations of victory and reverses. Congress leaders have flagged 16 constituencies green where they are predicting party victory, while they believe that opposition BJP might bag 13 seats.

Votes polled for the 29 Lok Sabha seats and by-elections for Chhindwara assembly seats would be counted amid tight security on Thursday. Going by internal assessment, Congress leadership has flagged Bhopal, Indore and Jabalpur constituencies as red and are not very positive. The assessment comes after the MLAs gave their feedback of the Lok Sabha elections in their respective assembly seats.

On Tuesday Chief Minister Kamal Nath had convened a meetings of the party legislators and Lok Sabha candidates to give feedback on the parliamentary elections. In presence of CM and party general Deepak Bawaria, the candidates and MLA gave detail report of the elections. Bhopal candi-

date Digvijaya Singh did not attend the meeting, but his representative gave the feedback.

On the basis of all the feedback received, the party leadership on a state map marked constituencies red and green ink. The party believes that position of the red inked seats is weak, while the party is sure of winning the seats marked in green ink. Bhopal, Indore and Jabalpur are among the constituencies where the party is not very positive, while position in Guna and Chhindwara is quite comfortable.

WELL-EQUIPPED CONTROL ROOM TO MONITOR RESULTS

The party has setup well equipped control room to monitor the phase-wise counting results; the CM Nath himself will be monitor the entire process. Nath would leave for his constituency Chhindwara around 3 pm to check on his assembly election results.



Congress media wing and Pradesh Congress Committee administration will keep a strict watch on the counting. At the party control room, big TV has been installed, besides it has four to five computers, printer, sheet with phone numbers of the district returning officers. Media vice president Bhupendra Gupta informed that on receiving any complaint they will call the concerned RO for the quick redressal. He informed that the monitoring will be done on the lines of assembly elections. Teams of advocates have been positioned at the counting centres and one team will be sitting at the PCC and if any legal question arises the team of senior advocates will give directors to the other advocates present at the district level.

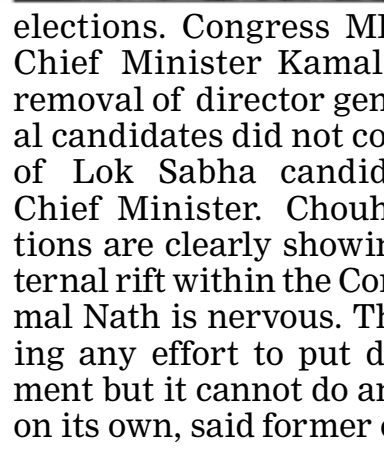
BSP, SP and Cong would bring govt down: Shivraj

Former Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, amidst political stir in the state before Lok Sabha poll results, has said that there is no need of floor test. Interacting with media, Chouhan said Congress government in the state would fall on its own.

Chouhan said Mayawati is angry over Congress candidate letting BSP candidate join Congress during elections. Congress MLA is threatening Chief Minister Kamal Nath demanding removal of director general of jail. Several candidates did not come in the meeting of Lok Sabha candidate convened by Chief Minister. Chouhan said the conditions are clearly showing that there is internal rift within the Congress and that Kamal Nath is nervous. The BJP is not making any effort to put down state government but it cannot do anything if goes fall on its own, said former chief minister.



RERA suspends Gammon India-Shrishti CBD project

BHOPAL: MP Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA), has taken the decision to suspend Bhopal CBD Project Shrishti CBD of Promoter Deepmala Infrastructure Private Limited Gammon House, Mumbai, with immediate effect. The promoter can only undertake construction and development work. The Authority took this decision as even after giving information to the promoter several times the project has not been present for regular review and due to non-submission of quarterly report. During the suspension period of the project, acquiring money for new bookings in the project and issuing new advertisement will be prohibited.

The counting of votes polled in 29 parliamentary seats in Madhya Pradesh will take place on Thursday amid tight security. Final results are expected by late evening though trends will be clear by afternoon. The results will decide the fate of leaders like Digvijaya Singh, Jyotiraditya Scindia, Rakesh Singh, Narendra Singh

Tomar and others. EVMs will be shifted from strong rooms to counting centres at 7am and counting will begin at 8am. Though results are expected to be declared late in the evening, decisive trends will emerge by 5pm.

Election Commission of India has made clear that mobile phone of the RO (Returning Officer), ARO (Assistant Returning Officer), Counting supervisors, linked to ETPBS (Electroni-

cally Transmitted Postal Ballot System), to be used to receive 'OTP' to log into ETPBS to start counting will be allowed inside the counting hall. The mobile handsets will be switched on only to receive 'OTP' and be switched off once the system is logged on to ETPBS. Inside the counting hall, such mobile handsets are to be kept in the custody of ARO/RO/Observer, whosever is the senior

most officer in the Counting Hall for ETPBS counting, in switched off mode till the counting is over. With more than 5.18 crore voters in MP, 71% came out to vote amidst scorching heat in four phases. Overall 438 candidates are in fray for 29 Lok Sabha seats. Bhopal had the highest number of contestants with 30 candidates in fray while Dewas witnessed contest between 6 candidates only.
