CM stops proposal to turn residential areas into commercial ones

22 VILLAGES TO BE SEPARATED FROM NAGAR PARISHAD

Chief Minister Kamal Nath has stopped a proposal put up before the cabinet for turning residential areas into commercial ones. Nath directed the officials to make a presentation on the proposal in front of him before sending it to the cabinet. The Chief Minister said the attempt to turn residential areas into commercial ones should not be a problem for residents. There should be parking lots and other facilities, and only then, such a proposal can be discussed. To legalise business activities in residential ar-

reas, the urban development department proposed mixed land use on more than 24-metre wide road with penalty. The cabinet also amended a proposal to make 30 Nagar Parishads into village Panchayats. After the amendment, 22 Nagar Parishads will be made village Panchayats, and eight will remain Nagar Parishads. According to sources, urban development minister Jaivardhan Singh discussed the matter with legislators from all those areas. Eight legislators told the cabinet to maintain Nagar Parishad status of their Panchayats so there will be no change their position.

HYBRID RENEWABLE POLICY TO BE IMPLEMENTED

The cabinet has decided to implement the 'Madhya Pradesh Hybrid Renewable Energy and Energy Storage Policy.' The policy will be implemented for the development of three projects. This will include electricity generation from two or more renewable energy sources at a project site in the Hybrid Power Project (HPP), which may also include energy storage. The Energy Storage Project (ESP), includes projects developed with various storage techniques like mechanical, chemical (battery), compressed air, hydrogen, pumped hydro

storage etc. with or without energy sources and expansion of existing renewable energy project under above the mentioned categories. In addition to the 'Madhya Pradesh Hybrid Renewable Energy and Energy Storage Policy,' co-located or stand-alone energy storage plants can be set up in existing renewable energy project sites so that renewable energy sources can be properly utilized. The need for a progressive policy to promote hybridization of various renewable energy sources and various types of energy storage was proposed to

utilize the available infrastructure and renewable energy sources. **MINISTERS' GRANTS INCREASED** The cabinet decided to increase voluntary grant to be given by a minister from Rs 20,000 to Rs 40,000. The cabinet approved expansion of assembly building and MLA rest house of the Urban Development and Housing Department. The Cabinet decided make amendment regarding the recruitment process in the State Service Examination Rules 2015 related to the State Service Examination held by the MPPSC.

Patwaris-in-waiting alleges lack of transparency in recruitment process

Thousands of Patwaris waiting for their postings through counseling have alleged non-transparency in the entire process. An RTI reply says about 1250 posts are vacant but officers are adamant that only few hundred posts are available for posting. The Patwari-in-waiting Association will meet revenue minister and other senior officials on Thursday to demand justice. The validity of results of selected candidates is getting expired on February 10. 'Revenue department had mentioned 9235 vacant posts in its advertisement. So far nine counseling rounds have been organized but the figures about selected candidates are not being revealed,' said office bearer of

of patwaris so Pradeep Mishra from Jabalpur filed an application seeking details. The reply received on January 25, 2020 on RTI application revealed that 1115 posts were vacant after fifth round of posting. Discouraging RTI activists, revenue department asked them to file applications district wise to seek district wise details as posting process is being carried on at district level. Reply received from about a dozen districts reveal that more than 300 posts were vacant in their districts till January month. The selected candidates are demanding extension of validity of their results by another six months as posting process was delayed by the government. They are also demanding transparency in the whole process.

Only 8% of 1.17 crore ration cards find place in genuine category

After food department's verification of ration cards only 8% have been successfully placed in genuine category after being linked with Aadhaar cards. After complaints of fake ration cards and food supplied in more than required quantity, food department decided to link the ration cards with Aadhaar card to ascertain genuine beneficiaries. In the previous regime government had made 1, 17, 19, 999 ration

cards. A verification drive started by current regime has slashed down lakhs of beneficiaries whose documents didn't stand scrutiny. Department, on the instructions of central government started linking the ration cards with Aadhaar cards and started biometric provisions to stop illegal leakage of subsidized food ration. Beneficiaries whose aadhaar cards have been linked can now buy ration from government outlets irrespective of their wards. They are placed under 'most genuine' category. Their number stands at 24,6701.

Director of Vignyan Kendra Hemant Sharma told Free Press, "Now, we are receiving calls on exam-related queries. Most of students asking how to prepare for the examination in less time, how to memorise and how to get more marks." "We also get questions related to subjects. We also have contact numbers of experts of various subjects. The students call and

ask their queries," he added. He further said, "We are not only getting calls from students but also from their parents across the state. The parents ask about their children not taking interest in study etc. Some local parents and students also visit the office for this purpose." "We run helpline in three shifts - from 8 am to 8 pm round the year for pre-examination, during examination, post examination, career counseling, and counseling after the supplementary exam. For this, we have 18 counsellors."

Non-SAS officers not to get any IAS post this year too

BHOPAL: Non-SAS officials in the state will not get any post of IAS-cadre this year too. Chief Minister Kamal Nath has decided to give all the posts of IAS-cadre to the officials of the State Administrative Services (SAS). The SAS has got 18 posts. For promotion to IAS, the Chief Secretary had sent a proposal to the Chief Minister for giving 14 posts to SAS and four to non-SAS cadres. Nevertheless, the Chief Minister has decided to give all the 18 posts to the SAS-cadre.

Guard's gun goes off accidentally at examination centre

Three students among four injured
Navy entrance exam was underway at JNCT college

A gun of guard at JNCT college went off accidentally after he fell down in a melee on Wednesday. The incident left three students and a peon injured. Police have arrested the guard and seized his gun. Etkheri SHO said Navy entrance exam was underway at the college when the incident occurred. The guard Jitendra Hansana, holding a loaded gun, was standing at the examination center's gate where the examinees had kept their bags and other belongings. When the exam concluded, scores of students rushed to collect their belongings. Peon Devi Prasad was distributing the bags and the armed

guard was standing close by when one of the students tried to take away his bag. However, the bag strap got entangled with the Guard's 12-bore gun which was hanging on his shoulder. The jerk made the guard lose his balance and as he fell down the loaded gun went off accidentally injuring three students and peon who was distributing bags. Bhupesh, a student who came from Gwalior received bullet injuries on his right hand; the other student Lokesh from Sehore received a slight scratch on face. A third student also received injuries. The police have registered a case under section 336 and 337 of IPC and have arrested the guard and seized the gun.

On adoption of Ind AS 116, the Group has recognised 'Right-of-use' assets amounting to INR 6,627.46 lakhs (including reclassification of lease prepayment from other assets amounting to INR 99.54 lakhs) and lease liabilities amounting to INR 6,527.92 lakhs as at 1st April, 2019. There is no impact on retained earnings as at 1st April, 2019.
