

According to the police, the incident took place between 3 am and 3.30 am. A group of thieves targeted the locked house of medicine trader Rakesh Jain. They entered the house after the break opening the door and managed to decamp with valuables and cash worth Rs 16 lakh.

Later, they reached another house of chartered accountant Nikhil Chopra and tied a cloth on CCTV. They entered the first floor of the house by climbing a tree. They locked Nikhil's room and went downstairs to his father Aieet Singh's room. When Ajeet woke up hearing some noise the accused attacked him and pointed a gun at his wife. They robbed cash and valuables worth Rs 5.50 lakh from there and fled. After committing robbery, the accused also pelted stones at several other houses in the colony.

## Gang looting train passengers busted, 4 held; two on-the-run

Government Railway Police (GRP) Bhopal have arrested four members of an interstate gang involved in looting train passengers, on Thursday. The Sanshi gang had six members and two of the accused are on the run. The thieves were arrested by police when they were about to board a train at

Gwalior railway station.

The cops have recovered the stolen goods worth over Rs 10 lakh from their possession. They have admitted their involvement in five cases.

They are being quizzed and it is likely that they would confess to their involvement in a few more cases. The accused would befriend the passengers on the train and would offer help to off load their luggage when their destination station was about to arrive. After placing the bags near entry gates, four other accused would encircle the bag and would relieve it of valuables. The clueless passengers would only come to know about theft after alighting from the train. Police said the accused were involved in burglaries in trains originating from Delhi and heading towards the Southern parts of India.

In accordance with the requirements of Ind AS 16 "Property, Plant and Equipment", the Company has reassessed the useful life of property, plant and equipments and has revised the estimated useful life of plant and machineries to 15 years from the existing useful life of 10 to 21 years on the basis of technical evaluation carried out by the management's expert. The effect of the said change is recognised prospectively w.e.f. 1" July 2020 as per the requirements of Ind AS 8 "Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors". Consequent to this change, depreciation is lower and net profit before tax is higher by INR 326.49 lakhs for the guarter ended 30" September 2020, INR 328.39 lakhs and INR 654.88 lakhs for the guarter and nine-months ended 31" December 2020. respectively. Further, the basic and diluted earnings per share (not annualised) is higher by INR 1.06 for the quarter ended 30" September 2020, INR 1.15 and INR 2.21 for the guarter and nine-months ended 31" December 2020 respectively.
