6 convicted for planting bomb near ex-Pondy CM's house

PUDUCHERRY: A special court in Puducherry has convicted six persons belonging to a fundamentalist Tamil outfit, Tamilar Viduthalai Padai for planting a bomb near the residence of former Chief Minister of Puducherry, V. Narayanasamy, officials said on Friday. On January 23, 2014, Narayanasamy's staff members found a bomb planted under a car in front of his official residence. The senior Congress leader was then the Chief Minister of Puducherry. Later, the National Investigation Agency (NIA) conducted a probe and arrested the culprits.

525 elephants died in TN in five years: Study

CHENNAI: A study by the Tamil Nadu Forest Department has revealed that 525 wild elephants have died in the state in the last five years. While 125 elephants lost their lives in 2017, 84 died in 2018, 108 in 2019, 110 in 2020, and 98 in 2021, according to the study. Despite the alarming deaths, the Central government has not sanctioned any funds under the 'Project Elephant' initiative in the past two years -- 2020-21 and 2021-22.

Kerala lifts quarantine rules for int'l passengers

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, Feb 4 (IANS) A meeting chaired by Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Friday lifted the quarantine norms for all international passengers coming to the state and also decided to reopen colleges and schools for classes 10 to 12 from February 7. This decision came after the meeting was held to review the existing Covid-19 guidelines in the state. These new guidelines have come at a time when the daily new Covid cases in Kerala in the past several days stood above 50,000, which decreased to 42,677 cases on Thursday.

Protest in old Hyderabad over attack on Owaisi

HYDERABAD: There was mild tension around the historic Mecca Masjid here on Friday as some people tried to take out a rally to condemn the attack on AIMIM President and Hyderabad MP Asaduddin Owaisi in Uttar Pradesh. After Friday prayers at the mosque, some people, especially youth, raised slogans condemning the attack and denouncing the BJP and UP Police. They tried to take out a rally but dispersed peacefully after advice from community elders. Security was also beefed up at other places in the old city of Hyderabad and other towns in Telangana to maintain law and order.

Centre unilaterally announced riverlinking project: Sidda

BENGALURU: Senior Congress leader Siddaramaiah on Friday accused the Central government of unilaterally announcing the river-linking project in the Union Budget without taking Karnataka into confidence, which, he said, was against the basic structure of the Constitution and federalism. He said Tamil Nadu is likely to gain benefit from the proposed project. Therefore, the Leader of Opposition in the Karnataka Assembly urged the State government to immediately call for an all-party meet to discuss and send the State's unanimous view to the Centre in this regard.

TN local bodies' polls: Multi-cornered contest on cards

CHENNAI: An interesting multi-cornered contest is on the cards for the urban local body elections in Tamil Nadu scheduled for February 19 with opposition parties, which were with the AIADMK till a few days ago, set to take on the ruling DMK banking on their respective party's own strength. The DMK, however, continued to project a picture of unity and managed to retain its allies hoping to repeat its resounding victory in the Assembly election last year.

K'taka opens theatres, pools, gyms, yoga centres

BENGALURU: Further relaxing Covid-19 curbs, the Karnataka government on Friday decided to allow theatres, gyms, yoga centres and swimming pools in the state to operate at full capacity. The decision was taken at a meeting chaired by Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai with the Health Minister, senior officials and technical advisory committee representatives. "Certain curbs like theatres, gyms, yoga centres, swimming pools among others to operate with 50 per cent capacity had continued. At today's meeting, it has been decided to relax these curbs by following certain precautionary measures," Health Minister K Sudhakar said.

ED attaches FDs of T'gana firm in money laundering case

NEW DELHI: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has attached assets of a Telangana-based company in connection with a money laundering case linked to the illegal manufacture of a scheduled drug, the federal agency said on Friday. A provisional order has been issued under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) to attach Rs 1.93 crore-worth fixed deposits of Hygro Chemicals Pharmatek Pvt Ltd located in Medak district of the state, it said in a statement. The company is accused of "illegally manufacturing and dealing" in a scheduled drug identified as Dextro Propoxyphene Hydrochloride.

WITH SHAH HIS SIDE, YOGI FILES NOMINATION FROM GORAKHPUR
Yogi worth just Rs 1.54 crore; revolver and gun his assets

On Friday, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath filed his nomination from home turf Gorakhpur in the presence of Union home minister Amit Shah. Incidentally, this is the first time the chief minister, who has represented Gorakhpur in the Lok Sabha five times, is contesting an assembly election.

In his election affidavit, Adityanath declared assets worth Rs 1,54,94,054 (Rs 1.54 crore). This includes cash in hand, balance in six bank accounts and savings. The chief minister also owns a Samsung mobile phone worth Rs 12,000, a revolver worth Rs 1,00,000 and a rifle worth Rs 80,000. Besides, he owns a gold ear ornament weighing 20 gm and worth Rs 49,000; his other valuables are a gold chain and Rudraksha neck ornament weighing 10 grams and worth Rs 20,000. But he does not own any agricultural or non-agricultural property, as per his poll affidavit. There is no vehicle registered in his name, nor does he have any liabilities.

Both Shah and Yogi addressed a rally before filing the nomination papers. Speaking on the occasion, Shah boasted

that the BJP would cross the 300-mark in the Assembly yet again. He pointed out that the people had reposed faith in the BJP in 2014, 2017 and 2019 elections and would continue to do so. He asserted that UP is prospering under the able leadership of Yogi and people would elect him with a vast majority. In a throwback to the year 2013, when he was made in charge of UP, Shah recalled that skeptics would say that the BJP would not even reach double digits. However, the BJP and its allies secured 323 seats in 2017; this time, too, the performance would be replicated.

People at top want weak CM: Sidhu's dig at Gandhis

Ahead of the announcement of the CM face for the Punjab Assembly polls by the Congress, party's state unit chief Navjot Singh Sidhu said "people at the top" want a weak chief minister.

"People at the top want a weak chief minister who can dance to their tune," Sidhu said addressing his supporters here on Thursday evening. He did not make it clear whether he was referring to the Congress central leadership or anybody else. When contacted, his media adviser said Sidhu was actually referring to the government at the Centre.



Sidhu's remark came at a time when Congress leader Rahul Gandhi is likely to announce the name of his party's chief ministerial candidate for the Punjab polls on Sunday in Ludhiana.

For the last several weeks, both Chief Minister Charanjit Singh Channi and Sidhu have directly or indirectly made a case for themselves to be declared as the party's nominee for the top post.

Addressing his supporters and workers after returning from Mata Vaishno Devi shrine in Jammu and Kashmir, Sidhu targeted SAD leader Bikram Singh Majithia, who is fighting against the Congress leader from Amritsar East.

UP election is about brotherhood vs BJP: Akhilesh

Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav on Friday took a swipe at the ruling BJP asking if anyone saw criminals fleeing the state as the party has been claiming.

He said the SP will ensure a historic defeat to BJP and will send Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath back to Uttarakhanda.

"Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar gave us the Constitution on which the country is run and this election is also about safeguarding the Constitution. "This is why Samajwadi Party is taking along people from all groups. This election is about brotherhood versus BJP," the SP chief said, addressing a joint press conference with his alliance partner Rashtriya Lok Dal (RLD) chief Jayant Chaudhary. "The people of the state will vote on issues and send the chief minister back to Uttarakhanda," Akhilesh said referring to Yogi Adityanath's ancestral roots in Uttarakhanda.

Asked about the attack on AIMIM chief Asaduddin Owaisi in Meerut on Thursday, the SP president said such incidents should not occur in a democratic nation. "People are saying that the criminals have left Uttar Pradesh. Did anyone see these criminals when they were leaving the state? Violence is not acceptable in democracy and it raises questions on the law and order situation in the state," Akhilesh said.
